Dr. Hope Italiano Lee has been the Lead Pastor of Kirkwood Presbyterian and The Well (an intentional re-plant of an existing congregation with a Kingdom eye towards the future) in Bradenton, FL for the last 9 years. She was the opening preacher for the Fellowship of Presbyterians Covenanting Conference in Orlando and speaks frequently at national events and conferences all over the country including the New Wilmington Mission Conference, Renewal by the Lake, and the National Discipleship Conference. Lee's passion is evangelism, church growth, and true redevelopment and revitalization of the church. She is an evangelism and redevelopment coach, working with pastors
