Parkminster Vision: Parkminster aspires to be a dynamic, Christ-led community, seeking and serving God and our neighbors. We take seriously the words that Paul spoke in Romans 12: 1,2. We live out our vision as follows:

Dynamic: We are passionate, persevering and energetic. We understand the need to adapt our methods, in our ever-changing world, but continue to be faithful to the message of the Gospel.

Christ-led: We trust in the risen, living Christ who is restoring all things to himself through the work of the Holy Spirit.

Community: We are a people growing in love, grace, authenticity, and forgiveness. We are forming a safe place of belonging, healing and restoration where we desire to seek out and welcome all people.

Seeking and Serving God: We value inspiring communal worship and preaching. We value small groups and mentoring as our approaches to discipleship. We strive to seek God through daily Bible study and prayer.

Seeking and Serving Our Neighbors: We seek to personally minister within our congregation, in our community, and in the world. We seek to dialog with our neighbors about the good news of the Gospel and the love of God

In summary, it is our deepest desire to give ourselves completely to God, to be led by the Holy Spirit, and to encourage each other to grow as disciples of Jesus Christ. We joyfully yield our lives to Jesus. In an ever-changing world, we aspire to serve our neighbors near and far, in a responsive and caring way.

How do you feel called to reach out to address the emerging needs of your community or constituency?

We are in a suburban middle-class neighborhood, with diverse family situations. Our ministries are designed to reach out to the community as well as minister to our congregation. We strive to minister to families in our neighborhood, the impoverished in the Rochester area, and some focused needs internationally.

Before COVID, several of our ministries included:

- Preschool, which has a long-standing reputation in the community
- Summer's Best Two Weeks sports camp and Prism Youth Ministries, attracting youth from the surrounding towns, reaching far beyond our congregation
- Flower City Work Camp with youth and adults repairing homes of the needy in Rochester

We have held numerous events each year where we invite the public, such as a summer picnic, winter carnival, and a show put on by our Prism youth group. Local needs are addressed through a food cupboard and a clothing donation shed. We have made missions trips to Haiti to support an orphanage run by some friends of Parkminster.

Our small groups include a men's group, a women's group, a group for college students and young adults, adult Sunday school, a "No Dumb Questions" discussion group, and a Lenten devotional study.

How will this position help you to reach your vision and mission goals?

We're seeking a pastor with passion and energy who can lead us to become a transformational church that is willing to find the best way to adapt our methods to the current times while remaining faithful to God's word. While our pastoral transition has lasted for several years, the addition of new ministry support staff has brought a renewed sense of focus and energy to our church family. We believe God is at work in our church and we are excited to partner with our new pastor in that work.

A pastor who demonstrates a fervent prayer life can encourage our fellowship to have the same. In this way, we can seek God's direction via the Holy Spirit through prayer, scripture and wise counsel.

It's important to have a church leader who can help us reach people of all ages and from diverse cultural backgrounds. We are especially seeking new ideas to take our ministries for families and the poor to the next level, and to assist us in welcoming new families, singles and young adults into our fellowship.

The style, content and energy level of preaching can encourage our church body to openly worship and grow into mature followers of Christ, as well as reach those that are seeking God. Pastoral guidance to reinvigorate small groups and mentoring can help us become the disciples that Christ desires of us.

We are passionate about the Gospel and long to reach more people so that they can also experience the love of God in their lives.

Spiritual

5. Provide pastoral care and visitation to the sick and shut-ins
6. Prepare parents for infant baptism (or dedication) and prepare children, with their parents, for their First Communion, Confirmation and membership in the church
7. Make visits to prospective church members and conduct new member classes
8. Moderate Session meetings and administer the policies and directives of Session
9. As Head of Staff, supervise and equip the chairs of the key church ministries, including the Worship Director, Youth Director, Family Ministry Coordinator, Elders, Deacon Moderator, Christian Education and Administrative staff
10. Support and work with the Trustees to develop and manage the church finances and facilities
11. Oversee communications to the congregation
